
Comparison of shape between 'The Cholmondeley Ladies' (unknown) and 'Harmony in Red' (Matisse)












The position can be evaluated by deciding the strenght of each reason or objection. Then, by weighing up the reasons against the objections the main position can be accepted or refuted.









